

International Dentist Program Deferment Policy (Approved by Executive Council March 3, 2009)

I. PURPOSE

This policy establishes the New Jersey Dental School International Dentist Program admissions deferment policy.

II. ACCOUNTABILITY

The Associate Dean for Student Affairs is responsible for this policy.

III. POLICY

Applicants to the International Dentist Program, (IDP) who are eligible for acceptance after a personal interview and bench test, but are not able to enroll due to limited space, can request a deferment for the next academic cycle, by completing the Admissions Deferment Request form.

The Associate Dean for Student Affairs, the Chair of the Admissions Committee, the Director of Admissions and Student Recruitment, and the Director of the International Dentist Program will review all completed forms. The New Jersey Dental School reserves the right to offer the opportunity of deferment to a maximum of 5 students of outstanding qualifications.

The Office of Admissions will inform the applicant if the deferment has been granted. As with any admitted student, **full acceptance is conditional upon a deemed favorable Disciplinary Disclosure Form and Criminal Background check.**

This deferment is valid for **one** academic year.

A \$10,000 tuition deposit will be required upon approval of the deferment and will be due within 30 days of the date the deferment is granted. This tuition deposit will reserve a seat in the academic year for which the deferment was granted, and will be applied to the first term tuition.

The \$10,000.00 deposit can be refunded, if the candidate declines the offer of admission in writing, by January 1st of the year of the intended enrollment. After January 1st of the year of intended enrollment, the tuition deposit is non-refundable.
